Account to Account Disclosure

Access Code:

Access to your account will be by means of a personal access code. You agree not to make this access code available to any person not authorized to transact business on your account. If you share your access code with other persons you are giving them electronic access to your account and authorizing them to process transactions. If you fail to maintain the security of your access code and we suffer a loss as a result, we may terminate your eBranch access immediately.

You may change your password at any time when you are using eBranch. We recommend you change your access code periodically. If you believe someone has gained access to your access code change it immediately and contact the credit union.

Transfer Limitations:

Your ability to transfer funds between certain accounts is limited by federal law, as stated in your deposit account agreement. Under these regulations pre-authorized electronic funds transfer from a savings or money market account will be limited to a total of six (6) per month.

Member Liability for Unauthorized Access:

You are responsible for all transfers you authorize under this agreement. If you share your access code with other persons, you are also responsible for any transactions they conduct on your accounts. Tell us immediately if you believe someone has used your access code and accessed your accounts through eBranch without your authorization. Telephoning us right away is the best way of keeping possible losses to a minimum. If you fail to notify us in a timely manner, you could lose your right to dispute the transaction.

If your statement shows transfers that you did not make, tell us at once. If you do not tell us within sixty (60) days after the statement was mailed to you, you may not get back any money lost after the sixty (60) days if we can prove that we could have prevented the loss had you told us in time.
